The AGM of National u3a was held on the 6^{th} October 2022, and some of you will be aware of the prior controversy about a proposal to raise the annual fees to National u3a in line with pension increases. After the meeting, the Board expressed their disappointment that none of the amendments or resolutions associated with membership subscription were successful. In effect this means that at this stage for 2023/24 and 2024/25, the Trust will remain underfunded.

The Board is preparing revised financial forecasts and an action plan. But they recognised the need for more discussion in order to ensure that they consider the concerns, views and aspirations of the u3a membership.

Legal Policies The last newsletter told you that all the essential Ash u3a legal policies were being updated. Each month you will be given a resume of a policy, with the website address where each policy is available in full.

1. Safe Guarding Policy and Procedure

This is written to enable the Committee to address issues where there are safeguarding concerns. Safeguarding includes incidents between members, concerns regarding abuse or neglect that a member might be experiencing outside of the u3a, health issues, or previous or pending criminal convictions. Ash u3a will strive to uphold the principles that those who are involved in incidents are entitled to:

- privacy
- be treated with dignity and respect
- lead an independent life and be enabled to do so
- choose how they live their lives
- the protection of the law
- have their human and civil rights upheld regardless of ethnic origin, gender, sexuality, impairment or disability, age, religious or cultural background.
