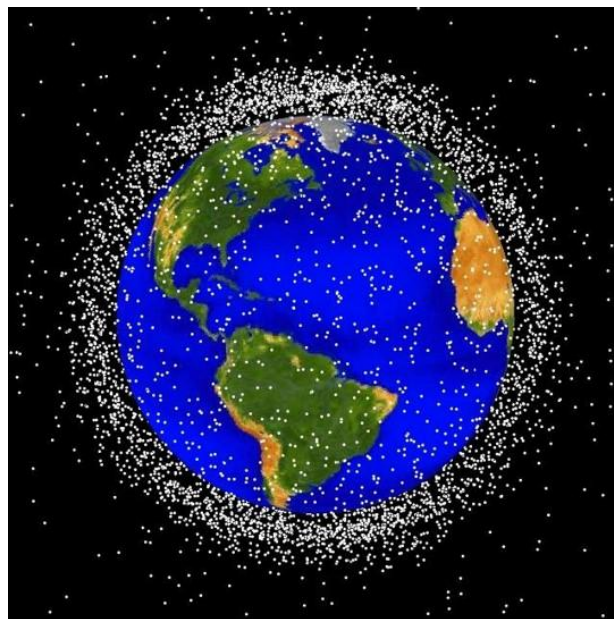

(On this day in history; 1967: Fighting in the Middle East ended after Israel finally observed the UN ceasefire and halted its advance into Syria. 1999: NATO called off its 11-week air war against Kosovo following the beginning of the withdrawal of Serb troops. 2000: Huge crowds of people were blamed for forcing the temporary closure of London's newest bridge on the day of its opening because of excessive swaying. 1955 (11th): Seventy-seven people were killed and 77 others were injured when two cars collided on the race track and crashed into the spectators' stand at Le Mans in north-west France. 1959 (11th): The 'Hovercraft' was officially launched in the Solent, off the South Coast)
