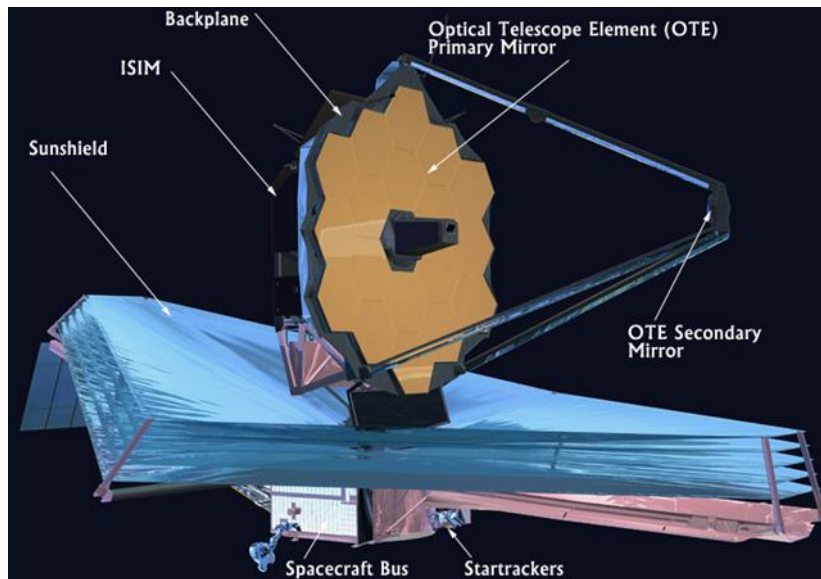

(On this day in history; 1959: Three hundred people were rescued after being cut off by a blaze on Southend Pier, the world's longest. 1985: Palestinian militants hijacked an Italian cruise liner, the Achille Lauro, and threatened to blow it up. They eventually shot dead a disabled American tourist and had his body thrown overboard with his wheelchair. 1981 (6th): President Sadat of Egypt was shot by gunmen who opened fire as he attended a military parade. 1985: (6th) A police officer was stabbed to death during riots at the Broadwater Farm housing estate in Tottenham, North London)
