

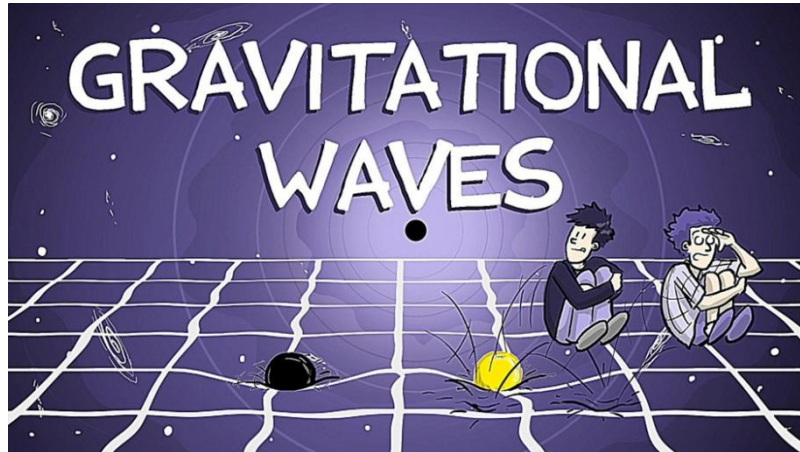

(On this day in history; 2nd 1953: Queen Elizabeth II was crowned. 2nd 1953: An RAF Chinook helicopter carrying more than 20 of Britain's top intelligence experts crashed on the Mull of Kintyre, killing everyone on board. 2nd 1966: The United States landed its first successful space probe (unmanned) on the Moon. 3rd 1962: An Air France Boeing 707 crashed on take-off at Orly Airport in Paris, killing 130 people on board. At the time the worst ever recorded air disaster involving one aircraft. 6th 1944: D Day. Thousands of Allied troops landed on the beaches of Normandy to start a definitive offensive)
